Application Process



- No current application cycle is in process
- Acceptance based on scoring system
 - Overseen by Vice President
 - Scored anonymously by 6-8 current member volunteers
 - Points given for service, honors, personal statement, etc.
 - Next application cycle for the Class of 2026 can accept 25% of the total class size into SSP



Application to Omicron Theta



- Application Eligibility
 - Cumulative GPA above 80%
 - Top 25% of class by GPA at the time of application
 - Must have completed one semester of course work
 - Good academic standing and without any Honor Code violations
 - Demonstrated service and community involvement



Application to Omicron Theta



- To Maintain membership all members must:
 - Pass all clinical rotations and courses
 - Not incur any honor code violations
 - Attend 50% of chapter meetings
 - Community service (June 30th-July 1st)
 - OMS-I: 15hrs (5 hours SSP)
 - OMS-II: 15hrs (5 hours SSP)
 - OMS-III: 10hrs (no required SSP)
 - OMS-IV: 10hrs (no required SSP)
